When required we will ship puppies by air only.

### **SHIPPING INFORMATION:**

(For shipping Puppies by Air)

The buyer will be responsible for all shipping costs which includes: health papers, shipping crate, transportation and airline fees.

(The Price of the puppy, and ALL shipping costs must be Paid in Full, BEFORE a puppy will be shipped.)

Vetinary Health Certiificate - \$65.00

Shipping crate and Liner - \$65.00

Transportation to Airport - \$50.00

Airline fees - \$150 - \$350 this will depend on distance and choice of shipper

In order to ship a puppy the temperature at departure, arrival, and anywhere in between, that the pup may be "on the ground", cannot exceed 80°F or be below 40°F.

(The exception to the temperature requirements above is "certain" airlines that offer "special handling" of live animals at a "higher" price. This is an option if you want to pay for it.)

We recommend that you bring the following with you when meeting your puppy at the airport: collar, leash, bowl and water, paper towels, bath towel and baby wipes. If the puppy has an accident while in transit, you will be very glad to have these supplies with you! The liner is the same material used in hospitals for bedridden patients. It is machine washable, soft, is chew- and stain-resistant, and wicks away moisture.

### **Details of Shipping**

We use several major airlines for shipping. The process is safe, simple, and cost

effective.

The pup first obtains a health certificate from a vet, this is good for 30 days. On the day of travel, he is placed in a transport kennel, and received by the airlines. He is placed on board just minutes prior to departure, and travels in a temperature controlled, pressurized area of the aircraft. (If he loses pressure, so do the passengers!) The pup usually sleeps for most of the flight. The pup never really knows that he is on an airplane. This is usually less traumatic than traveling by car.

### **Picking up your puppy**

You will have already received an email from us advising you of flight numbers, times and Air Bill numbers.

Just simply show up at the baggage claim or Air Freight Area (a call beforehand is a good idea to find out where they are located). Show them your I.D. and they will hand your pup to you.

Other than water, there is nothing special you will need. You can bet he will need a potty break ASAP.... Find the nearest grass area.

Your pup will be happier if you hold him in the car. He will most likely go back to sleep.

### **COST**

Shipping through the airlines is the best way to get your puppy safe and sound. The total cost of transporting your puppy is about \$375.00.
